End User Licence Agreement

SiteVector (ABN 34 124 561 993), a sole trader registered in Victoria, Australia

1. Introduction

This End User Licence Agreement ("Agreement") is between you ("User") and SiteVector (ABN 34 124 561 993), a sole trader registered in Victoria, Australia ("Licensor", "we", "us"). By accessing or using the SiteVector platform, you agree to the terms of this Agreement.

If you are accepting on behalf of an organisation, you represent that you have authority to bind that organisation to this Agreement.

This Agreement should be read together with our Terms of Service, Privacy Policy and Cookie Policy.

2. Licence Grant

Scope differs between team-based and single-user products

Subject to this Agreement and payment of applicable fees, SiteVector grants you a limited, non-exclusive, non-transferable, revocable licence to access and use the platform for the purpose of managing and recording construction project operations.

The scope of the licence depends on the product:

Product	Licence scope
Commercial and Civil project tiers	Granted on a per-project basis for the duration of the applicable access tier, covering the project team invited to that project. Named individuals may be added and removed by the project administrator.
Residential licence	Granted to one named registered user for 12 months. The licence is personal to that user and may not be shared, transferred or used concurrently by others.
60 day trial (evaluation)	Where evaluation access is granted at our discretion, in respect of a Commercial, Civil or Residential project: 60 days, for evaluation purposes only. For Commercial and Civil the licence covers the project team; for Residential it is granted to one named registered user.
7 Day Showcase (evaluation)	Where evaluation access is granted at our discretion, in respect of a Commercial, Civil or Residential project: one named registered user, 7 days full access followed by 7 days read-only access, for evaluation purposes only.

Evaluation access is not offered for sale and no person is entitled to it. It may be declined, varied, shortened or withdrawn at any time, and ends automatically at the conclusion of its stated period. While it is held, this Agreement applies in full.

The platform is provided as a hosted service accessed through a web browser. No software is supplied to you for installation, and this Agreement grants no right to obtain a copy of the platform or its source code.

3. Licence Restrictions

You must not:

- Copy, modify, adapt or create derivative works of the platform or any part of it

- Reverse engineer, decompile, disassemble or attempt to derive the source code of the platform
- Remove or alter any proprietary notices, labels or marks
- Sublicence, sell, resell, transfer, assign or otherwise commercialise the platform or your access to it
- Share credentials for a single-user licence, or allow a single-user licence to be used by more than the one registered user
- Use the platform to build a competing product or service
- Access the platform through automated means, including scraping or crawling
- Attempt to alter, forge or circumvent a sealed record, its fingerprint or its verification status
- Use the platform in any way that violates applicable laws or regulations

Attempting to defeat or falsify record sealing undermines the integrity the platform exists to provide, and is a material breach of this Agreement. Sealed records are verifiable by design, and alterations are detectable.

4. Ownership

4.1 The platform

The platform, including its design, codebase, structure, classifications, reason-code frameworks, algorithms, calculations and visual presentation, is and remains the exclusive property of SiteVector. This Agreement grants a licence to use the platform only, and transfers no ownership.

4.2 Your data

You retain ownership of the data you enter into the platform. You grant SiteVector a limited, non-exclusive licence to store, process and present that data for the purpose of providing the platform, and a perpetual licence to use anonymised and aggregated derivatives as described in our Terms of Service and Privacy Policy.

5. Records, Sealing and Verification

The platform locks and cryptographically seals each day's record. Where a day is not locked manually, it is locked and sealed automatically overnight. Sealed records carry a fingerprint and QR code that any person you provide the record to can verify publicly, without logging in, to confirm the record has not been altered since sealing.

You acknowledge that:

- Sealing demonstrates that a record has not changed since it was locked. It does not verify that the entries were accurate or truthful when made
- Where a locked record is unlocked to make a correction, the unlock is permanently logged with the user, time and reason, and the unlock and re-seal counts are disclosed on verification
- Where you share a sealed record, the recipient will be able to verify it as described above
- SiteVector gives no assurance as to how any record will be treated in a claim, adjudication, dispute or proceeding

6. Term, Expiry and Termination

This Agreement begins when you first access the platform and continues while you hold a valid licence.

On expiry of a paid access period, read-only access is available for a further six months, after which access is removed and project data is archived. Trials and Showcase accounts end at the conclusion of their stated periods.

We may suspend or terminate this licence where you materially breach this Agreement, where fees remain unpaid, or where your use poses a genuine risk to the platform, other users or record integrity. Except where immediate action is required for those reasons, we will first give you written notice and a reasonable opportunity of at least 7 days to remedy the problem, consistent with Section 11 of our Terms of Service. On termination your right to access the platform ceases.

You may export your data at any time while you have access. We recommend retaining your own copies of any records you may need after access ends. Data retention after access ends is governed by our Privacy Policy.

7. Warranties and Liability

7.1 No warranty as to outcomes

The platform is provided on an "as is" basis. To the extent permitted by law, we make no warranty that the platform will be uninterrupted or error free, or that records produced through it will achieve any particular commercial or legal outcome.

7.2 Limitation

Subject to Section 7.3, and to the maximum extent permitted by law, SiteVector's total liability under or in connection with this Agreement is limited to the total fees paid by you in the twelve months preceding the claim. We are not liable for indirect, consequential, special or incidental loss, including loss of profit or loss of business opportunity.

This limitation does not apply to, and we do not seek to limit, our liability for fraud, for wilful misconduct, or for death or personal injury caused by our negligence.

7.3 Australian Consumer Law

Nothing in this Agreement excludes, restricts or modifies any guarantee, warranty, right or remedy conferred by the Australian Consumer Law that cannot lawfully be excluded, restricted or modified. Where liability can be limited, our liability is limited to resupplying the services or paying the cost of having them resupplied.

8. General

8.1 Changes

We may update this Agreement from time to time. A change that materially disadvantages you will not be applied to an access period you have already paid for, and will instead take effect when you next purchase, renew or extend access.

Where a change must apply during a current access period because the law requires it or to keep the platform secure, we will give you at least 30 days written notice, and you may terminate within that period and receive a pro rata refund of unused prepaid fees. We will notify active users of material changes by email or through the platform.

8.2 Governing law

This Agreement is governed by the laws of Victoria, Australia, and you submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Victoria.

8.3 Severance and survival

If any provision is found unenforceable, the remaining provisions continue in force. Sections 3, 4, 5, 7 and 8 survive termination or expiry of this Agreement.
